I have experienced this privilege at our many graduation celebrations throughout the years.

What a joy it is to witness and celebrate truly transformed lives!

As the graduates share their story they often end with a passionate commitment to help lift others even as they have been lifted.

As we celebrate a new year, it's the perfect time to say thank you for making new life possible for the men, women, and children that we serve every day.

Thank you for providing the services that lead to healthy relationships. It's there, in relationship and community, that lives really begin to change; to become new. It's there, in the day to day conversations, shared meals, intimate group discussions, and times of worship that we get to see the slow and beautiful transition from self-destruction to self-sufficiency.

Over time and through supportive relationships our shelter guests and program participants can integrate into the local community. When they do, they're supported by mentors, community based-recovery groups, and churches. And I'm happy to say that 81% of those who graduated in the last four years from our Restoration Programs are addiction free and in housing. Simply put, they're new – experiencing the overwhelming joy of a brand new life.

Help keep our neighbors warm this winter by donating coats, hats, gloves, scarves, blankets, hand warmers, jeans and sweatshirts.



My challenge had always been alcohol.

I realized I couldn't do it on my own and I needed help. The Harbor has been just that, a safe harbor. God has provided in every way imaginable.

While 2020 has been a year filled with challenges, it's been a blessed year for me.

Before I came here I was on the street, homeless, destitute. I was without hope. I am now full of hope." I came to Shepherd's Door to face my shame and trauma so I could become a strong woman, which I have become. What made this change happen was LOVE.

Now I have confidence for the first time in staying sober. I have the most intimate relationship with God. I have hope. I have self-worth. I have the best relationship I've ever had with my family. I have learned to be a better parent. I now have a savings account.

But the most important thing is that I know I am loved." I was homeless, living in a tent and pregnant. I would cry and ask myself, "How did I allow myself to get this low?

I was all alone when my contractions began. I almost didn't make it to the hospital in time. When my son was born DHS removed him from my care.

When I came to Shepherd's Door I was lost, hurt, broken, with no self worth, dying inside.

But now I have my son and my DHS case is closed! I am alive and full of selfworth. God changed me at Shepherd's Door and saved my life."
