Trauma leads to homelessness. Homelessness causes additional trauma. Isolation, job loss, housing costs, and life-crisis darken the landscape, and yet there is a beacon of hope shining bright 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. For 71 years now Portland Rescue Mission has been here as a conduit of your kindness, providing emergency services and life-restoring programs to people struggling with hunger, homelessness and addiction. But for the past year that simply was not enough.

The needs rose, and thanks to your ongoing support our response was able to rise along with it.

We quadrupled our nursing care, invested in an outreach program to extend services to those sheltering in tent encampments, and went to great lengths to ensure the health and safety of our guests, our volunteers and our staff. Every provided service granted us the opportunity to build trust with our guests. That is the key; building a foundation of relational trust so that we might have the privilege of walking beside someone and assisting them toward a better life.

"I looked at my newborn baby and asked, "Can I do this?" I knew I couldn't do it by myself. I felt God calling me to Shepherd's Door. The past 12 months have been amazing. I now have 21 months clean for the first time in my life. I'm growing into the woman and mother I had only dreamed about."



"You have created a home to restore broken souls like me. I will be seeking education to become a drug and alcohol counselor. I want to thank all of Shepherd's Door staff for helping me succeed and believing in me when I didn't believe in myself. I am forever grateful."



"I truly have a life that I never imagined. I wake up in the morning and I'm grateful for my job. And one of the best things that I have received at The Harbor was the relationship with my mother. I get to be the son that I should have been."
