care and a fresh start to **over 6,000 people**. We are honored to share that **four out of five men and women who graduate from our New Life Program remain addiction-free and in stable housing five years** after completing the program.

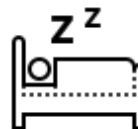

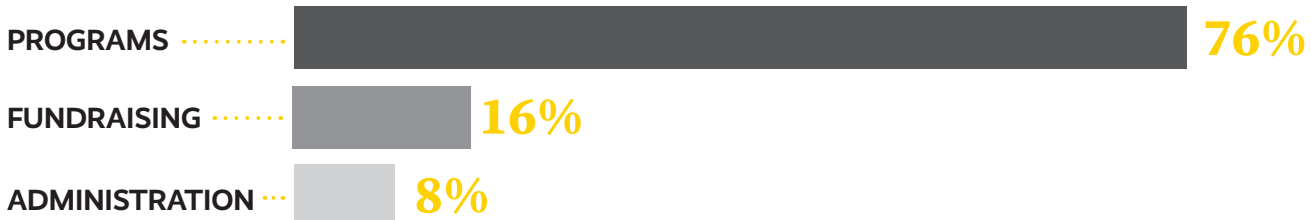
