
GIVING BACK

Samantha's Story of Transformation

Samantha's life was plagued by addiction and abuse. Desperate, broken, and on the verge of losing her children, Samantha felt her life wasn't worth living anymore. In her darkest hour, she cried out to God...

SAMANTHA'S STORY OF TRANSFORMATION, continued



Samantha's childhood was marked by deep trauma. "I come from a long line of addiction, incest, and abuse," she recalls. By adulthood, she found herself trapped in an abusive relationship, her addiction at its peak, and on the verge of losing both her children.

"I was about to lose my daughter... CPS was involved, and they were going to take my son, too. I was terrified."

In despair, Samantha dropped to her knees and prayed for God to find someone safe to take her kids, because she was planning to end her life. "I told God they deserved better... and I heard this voice say, 'if they deserve better, then let's get better." That was her turning point. She searched for treatment programs that allowed children, and that search led her to Shepherd's Door.

During her first days at the Mission, Samantha fought to overcome feelings of unworthiness. "I was deep in my shame, uncomfortable in my own skin. But everybody here was glowing. I thought, 'I want to be like that." Slowly, she began to understand that the love she felt was real.

"The community here pours into you, they speak truth and God's love over you. I've never had a love like that."

Over time, Samantha noticed a profound shift: "I was in survival mode before. Now there's so much peace about me. I'm becoming a better mom, and I'm a woman I can be proud of." She's also grown spiritually: "My identity is in God now. I'm not my past or my mistakes."

This Christmas, Samantha is experiencing the gifts of peace and hope and celebrating the chance to give back by helping other women heal and grow. Thank you for giving generously to help support people like Samatha on their journey to transformation!
